

Ruby Valley Guide Meridian Through T.S. 40 N
between Ranges 55 & 56 E

June 28th 1896

I begin at the cor. to T.S. 39 & 40 N
R. 55 E. which is a stone firmly set
in ground, 17.00^{chs} N. of closing cor. to
T.S. 39 N. R. 56 E.; as described in
field notes supplied; and which I
found erroneously marked with 6 notches
on N. E. & S. edges; the E marks partially
obliterated; and with 4 pits, and
mound of earth and stone. I change
those marks to indicate cor. to T.S. 39 & 40
N., R. 55 E., by obliterating E marks
renewing N & S. marks, adding 6 notches
on W. edge, filling up E pit, and
redigging N. S. & W. pits (at original
distance of 6 feet, as being most expedient
and raising mound of earth ~~32~~ 4
feet 3 ft high, alongside former mound,
W. from cor. stone
On June 27 12.56.3^m astronomical
mean time, or June 28. 0.56.3 a.m.
local mean time, as indicated by my
