Retracement and resurvey of E. boy of  
 T 45 N. R. 51 E

August 28<sup>th</sup> Arriving in the vicinity of T 45, after  
 flagging the line of parallel. I went to  
 meadow and corral in the interior, where  
 I had directions both from the Surveyor  
 General and E. C. McClellan C. E. which  
 should enable me to find corrs. so  
 as to retrace part of E. boy, and make  
 proper connection, thence with line  
 of the Ninth Standard Parallel.  
 A diligent search on 29<sup>th</sup> failed to  
 find any that could be identified;  
 though the land marks were evident; but  
 happening on to stake (apparently intended  
 to replace a U.S. stake) lying beside  
 what might be an old cor., not far  
 from line where from topographical  
 evidence section line should be.
