

Retracement and resurvey of E. boy of T. 45 N. R. 51 E

that I could obtain. no reliable information as regards distance in that line. Around the place where T. cor should be, under all, and every supposition, diligent search was again instituted, (and, again, even, on Sept^r 1st); but no trace of a cor. exists in the neighbourhood.

Accordingly on Augt 31st after checking h. line, with secant, and correcting for a few minutes, difference (meridian error), I establish permanent monuments on the E boy line, as described in following field notes.

Augt 31st 1896

At cor of T's. 44 + 45 N. R's. 51 + 52 E.

found unmarked stake in mound of ash and replaced it. (re-established cor.) by

setting granite stone 20 x 14 x 6 or 15 ins in ground, for cor. of above named T's;

marked with 6 stakes on N. S. E. + W. cor.

and building rock mound 2 1/2 bars 1 1/2 high, S. of cor. (cor. lying near road pits not expedient)
