

General Description

All of this township surveyed in this compact is mountainous & poorly watered, but affords good grazing.

What are known as Carlin Hot Springs are situated in Sec. 8. and there are enclosed fields in sections 6. 7. 8 & 17.

There is no indication of minerals.

A few juniper bushes are to be found but no timber.

In some cases it was impossible to set rocks to the depths required in the manual but in every ^{such} instance they are set to the bedrock & firmly established.
