

## Subdivisions F. 34 &amp; A. 53 C

Survey commenced April 27<sup>th</sup> 1896 with a  
W. & L. C. Gurley Light mountain Transit  
the adjustment of which was tested & proved  
correct on April 13 & by subsequent observation

At the corner to Secs 1. 2. 35 & 36 on the South  
boundary I find by angular observation  
the magnetic variation to be  $17^{\circ} 28' E$ .

Thence I run North bet. Secs. 35 & 36.

Ascend in scattering juniper bushes.

3100 Ridge W.

4000 Set a volcanic rock 15x10x6 ins. 10 ins. in  
the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on W face  
dug pits 18x18x12 ins. N & S. 3 ft. dist and raised  
a mound of earth  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high W of cor.
