Survey commenced May 4th 1896 with
a W. & L. G. Surley light mountain
transit with solar attachment the
adjustments of which were tested and
verified on April 13th and by subsequent
observation.

At the corner to Secs. 1, 2, 35 & 36 on the S. bdy
established by me on May 3rd I find by
angular observation the Variation to be
17° 29' E.

Then I run,

R bet Secs 35 & 36

Road C. & D. W.

4000

Set a redwood post 3 ft. long 3 ins. sq. with
marked stone 24 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec.
or marked 1/4 S. on W. face, dug pits 18x18x12.
