

General Description

This portion of this township surveyed under this contract is generally mountainous. Consisting of deep canyons running from South Fork Mountain.

There are enclosures & some cultivation in sections 13, 14, 15 & 25. and some land in Secs. 11, 12, 16 & 20 would make good agricultural land with irrigation.

There has been considerable growth of junipers in the S.W. portion but all of any size have been cut out for firewood.

The South Fork of the Humboldt River flows through the eastern part, mostly in deep precipitous canyons, and there are numerous springs along its banks.

In some cases it was impossible to set stones to the prescribed depths but all were established firmly and as deep as practicable.
