light mountain transit with solar
attachment and double verniers
ready to single minutes of arc which
also is the smallest reading of the
decl. & lat. arcs.

I begin at the cor. to secs. 31 & 32 already
described from which by angular
measurement the orientation is $17^{\circ}30'$.
