Sixth Standard parallel N. thro.
Range 55 E.

Survey commenced August 31st
1896 with a W. & L. Gurley light
mountain transit with solar
attachment with double verniers
reading to single minutes which
is also the smallest reading on the
latitude & decl. arcs.

The transit was tested on the
true meridian at Reno and there
examined and approved by the
Surveyor General.

I begin at the standard corner
to Secs. 35 & 36 T. 31 N. R. 55 E.
which is a post plainly marked
with mound & pit as described
in the field notes furnished by the
Surveyor General.
