Sixth Standard parallel N. thro R. 52 E

September 19th 1896 I set over the corner to Secs 32 + 33 which is a cedar post properly marked & witnessed as described in the field notes supplied by the Surveyor General save a partial filling in of pit which I restore, and at 11^h 54^m a.m. L. m. A. I set off 1° 4' N on the decl. arc and observe the sun on the meridian.

The resulting latitude is $40^{\circ} 32' N$.

Thence I run E on S boundary of sec. 33 and at 40 chs find no trace of old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

At 80 chs I find traces of mound apparently the old corner 1 ch North of line.

I return to the corner to Secs 32 + 33 and at 3 p.m. L. m. A.
