After diligent search I am unable to find any trace of old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

Set a redwood post 3 ft long 3 inches square with marked stone 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on W. face dug pit 18x18x12 ins N & S. 3 ft. distant and raised a mound of earth $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high west of post.

4600 Gulch 15 lrs wide N.E.

7972 ^{to old corner} Intersect 6th Standard parallel N. at a point 1 chain 5 lrs E of the corner to secs. 35 & 36
