

General Description

The whole of this township is mountainous, is fairly well watered by creeks + springs and affords good grazing. The only agricultural land is in Sec 17 comprising about 100 acres.

There is a scattering growth of scrub juniper to the east of Discle creek valuable only for firewood + too small & bushy to be available either for lime or ~~not~~ bearing trees.

In some instances it was impracticable to set rocks to the full depth required by the manual but in these cases I set them to bedrock + firmly in the ground beyond possibility of accidental disturbance.
