Being unable to find the $\frac{1}{4}$
sec. cor. bet. Secs. 24 & 35 I commence at
the corner to Sect. 23, 35 & 36 on the N. bdy.
Oct. 4th at 11^h. 49^m. A.M. b.m.f. Set off
44° 45' on the decl. arc and observe the sun on the meridian.
The resulting latitude is 40° 37' N.

From the said corner described in the notes of subdivision,
I run N. bet. Secs. 24 & 35.

In mountains, ascend.

1800 Ridge N. N. E.

3850 Ravine N. N. E.

4000 After diligent search I am unable to find any trace of old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec.
It is a well worn post 3 ft. long 3 ins. sq. with
marked stone 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$
sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on N. face, dug
pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. E & W. 3 ft. deep
and caused a mound of earth 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft.
base 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high N. of corner.
