

# W. bdy of T. 32 R. 54 E.

Survey commenced October 29<sup>th</sup>  
1846 with a W. L. E. Gurley light  
mountain transit with solar attachment  
the adjustments of which were recently  
tested & proved correct.

Knowing from my survey of the  
West boundary of T. 32 R. 55 E.  
that a closing corner will be  
necessary. Run

N. 10<sup>th</sup> Secs 31 & 36.

In mountains & scattering scrub juniper

2000 Spur C.

4000 Set a volcanic rock 18x4x6 ins. 10 ins  
in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor. marked off  
on W. face and raised a mound of  
stone 3 1/2 ft. base 1 1/2 ft. high. No of cor.

5000 Wood road in ravine C.

6800 Spur C.

8000 Set a volcanic rock 17x10x8 ins.
