## General Description

This township is generally mountainous & watered by small creeks & springs, constituting a fine summer grazing range.

There are several mountain enclosures as shown on the plat and traces of mineral ore observable throughout the Township particularly in the south two tiers of sections.

There is a growth of scrub cedar & juniper in places too small & bushy for use either as line or bearing trees.

In some instances I was unable to set stones to the full depth required in the manual but set all stones firmly in the ground far beyond any possibility of accidental disturbance.
