In mountainous descent

1400 Low divide SW & NE.

4000 Like quartzite rock 12 x 10 x 5 ins 8 ins in the ground
for 1/2 sec. cor. marked W on W. face and raised a
mound of stone 2 ft. base 2 ft. high W of cor.

6000 Small spring on line

6840 Road from Gold Creek E.

7350 Shallow Ravine SE.

7740 Intersect 8th Standard parallel N. 5 Chs. W of 4th Sec
cor. on S. edge of sec. 31 which is a rock firmly set &
properly marked & witnessed a party with Surgeon
General's field notes. At the point of intersection on
S. edge quartzite rock 14 x 8 x 9 ins 9 ins in the ground
for closing cor. to sec. 56 marked CC on S with
1 groove on W and 5 on E edges & raised a mound of stone
2 ft. base 2 ft. high S. of corner.
