5200 Enter tableland. Spring in aspens N45 W. 18 shades.

7756 Intersect Edge of sp. 1400 of cor to sec 64<sup>1/2</sup> which is a rock firmly set & properly marked & agreeing with Salvago's general field notes, which I made the cor to sec 64<sup>1/2</sup> only by moving around to East.

& at the point of intersection set a volcanic rock  $22 \times 14 \times 9$  ins 16 ins in the ground for cor to sec 1412 marked with 5 notches on  $\frac{1}{2}$  in W edge & raised a mound of stones ft. base 2 ft. high W of ea.
