General Description

While this township is, generally speaking, mountainous, the soil is good & considerable land in the bottoms is susceptible of agriculture. It is well watered by creeks & springs.

There are settlements & cultivated fields in Secs 3, 10, 25, 26, 35 & 36.

There is some aspen & cottonwood timber in the S.W. portion suitable for fence posts &c.

In some cases I could not set rocks to the full depth required in the manual without blasting, but all are finally set as deep as practicable.
