

General Description

This township embraces the head waters of the Bruncau River.

A large portion of the land more particularly in the eastern ^{part} ~~portion~~ is good agricultural soil & can be irrigated with little difficulty. There is an encl^{ave} in secs 20, 21, 28 & 29 and in secs 6 & 7 where hay is made.

The township is well watered by the Bruncau river and its affluents.

In some cases I could not set stones to the full depth required in the manual work of blasting, but in such cases set the same firmly in the ground as deep as practicable & beyond the risk of accidental disturbance.
