

# Re-Survey of S. bdy of

August 20<sup>th</sup> 1897 From the cor to Tps 44 & 42  
 N Range 59 E which is a volcanic  
 rock firmly set & properly marked  
 with pieces of mound & pits, & which I  
 restore by raising a mound of stone  
 2 1/2 ft base 1 ft high W of cor. I run  
 S 89° 57' W on a blank line and at  
 4000 after diligent search can find no  
 trace of old 1/4 sec cor.

80.02 Atm to Sec 35, 36 1 & 2 which is a rock  
 properly marked lying on ground with  
 remains of small rock mound which I  
 restore; bears N. 1 ch. 15 lks distant.

To ascertain the true status of this line  
 I continue my line west and find many  
 of the corners <sup>nearly</sup> obliterated & the whole line  
 is defective, both as to course and  
 distance that a re-survey becomes  
 necessary as follows.
