

Re-survey of <sup>25</sup> East boundary <sup>75</sup>  
of  
T42 N R59 E

August 23<sup>rd</sup> 1897 at the corner to  
Tps 41 & 42 N R 59 E Set off at S. a. m.  
44° 31' N on the lat. arc and 11° 14' N  
on the decl. arc and determined true  
meridian with the solar.

Hence I run South bet Sec 4 & 31 & at  
11.45 find traces of old mound & pits which  
I restore at the same point by setting  
a cottonwood post 3 ft long 4 in. sq  
with marked stone 24 in. in the ground  
for corner to Tps 41 & 42 N R 59 E  
marked

T42 N R 60 E S. 36 on NB  
& T44 N R 60 E S. 6 on SE with 6 notches  
on N S & E edges, dug pits 30 x 24 x 18  
ins on each line N & S 4 ft + E of cor  
8 ft dist and raised a mound of  
earth 5 ft base 2 ft high E of cor.
