

## General Description

I have endeavored to grade the land in this township as follows, what is described as first rate is alluvial bottom land where water can be readily obtained & is good land for any sort of the hardier crops. Second rate is <sup>good</sup> land lying higher on the mountain slope and remote from water & requiring considerable expense in ditching &c. while 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> rate land is mostly useful for pasturage only.

There is also considerable good land in bottoms in the interior of sections, and there is good grazing land throughout.

Many Rivers, Kankakee Creek & affluents afford good water facilities.

There is no marketable lumber in the township.
