

General Description

The land in this township is generally of superior quality requiring only irrigation to be good tillable land, although mountainous.

There are large enclosures in secs. 17 18, 19 20 21 28 29 & 30 partly cultivated, also in 25 26 27 35 & 36 and in secs 12 13 & 24.

The township is well watered by Cottonwood, Camp & Snake Creeks. There is no timber of any value in the township except willows & cottonwood in the bottoms.

There has been no discovery of mineral
