November 18th 1897 at lat. 30° 45' N. Day off the
azimuth to the West.

The magnetic bearing of the true meridian
is N 17° 55' W which reduced by the table
on page 100 of the manual gives mean
mag. decl. 17° 53' E.

The south boundary having been
already run East on a random line
as reported in field notes of Estueros of
5439 P. C. E. to a closure according
the prescribed limits necessitating
only adaptation of the random for the
true line; from the corner to spot 42448 N
