 4 feet cor. bet 1 & 36 in mound stone 3 ft  
 high 3 ft base. Pits impracticable  
 48.00 Direct descent  
 80.00 Set basalt stone 30 x 9 x 3 in mtd 1 mtd  
 on E & S on Wedges for cor. poles 1, 2,  
 35 & 36 in mound stone 3 ft base 2 ft  
 high. Pits impracticable
