South bet Secs 31 & 36.

- 10.00 Ridge E & W
- 21.00 Draw east about east Ascend steep
- 40.00 Set basalt stone  $18 \times 10 \times 8$  ins 14 ins in ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. bet Secs 31 & 36 mtd  $\frac{1}{4}$  on West. Raised mound of stone 2 ft base  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft high W. of cor. Pits impracticable
- 42.00 Ridge E & W
- 65.75 Draw course east.
- 74.20 Set flag - The cor. to T. 41 & 42 N., R. 61 & 62 E. bears West 5.50 Chs. At 4 pm I set off  $3^{\circ} 45' S$  on dead arc &  $41^{\circ} 28' N$  on lat arc, & check my last sight <sub>32.00 Chs</sub> on line bet Secs 31 & 36

Oct 3<sup>rd</sup> After resurvey of s. bdy. I remove flag from my 74.20 Ch. point & set basalt stone  $16 \times 10 \times 6$  ins 12 ins in ground for cor to T. 42 N., R. 61 & 62 E mtd 6 notches on N. E & W edges & raised mound
