

## Resurvey of E. Bdy. T42 N., R. 62 E

South on true line on W. Sec. 31.

Ascending north slope

13.00 Draw course east

40.03 Set basalt stone  $18 \times 13 \times 12$  ins <sup>on W</sup> 14 ins  
in ground for cor. to Sec 30 mtd 's  
on W. dug pits  $18 \times 18 \times 12$  ins 3 ft  
N of cor. & raised mound of  
earth  $3 \frac{1}{2}$  ft base  $1 \frac{1}{2}$  ft high W of cor.

47.03 The cor. to Tps 41 & 42 N., R. 62 & 63 E  
described on page 3.

I re-establish this cor as cor to  
Tps 41 & 42 N., R 62 E, on W bdy  
of T42 N R 63 E. Obliterate all  
markings to east and add to  
the 6 notches on N.W. & S edges,  
42 N 62 E on NW face & 41 N on SW face  
dug pits  $30 \times 24 \times 12$  ins on each line  
N of 4 ft SW 8 ft from cor.; and  
raised a mound of earth 5 ft base  
 $2 \frac{1}{2}$  ft high W. of cor.

80.06 The cor to Tps 41 & 42 N., R. 62 & 63 E  
which is a post 2 ins sq 3 ft long
