

N Body T 38 N R 54 E

The cor of T. 37 and 38 N R 54 and 55 E being a slate badly decayed with markings nearly obliterated. Traces of pits and mound still distinguishable. I reset this corner in place by setting ^{granite stone} a 20x8x6 ins 15 ins in the ground for the cor of T 37 and 38 N R 54 and 55 E. Marked with 6 notches on the N-E-W and S edges. T 38 N on NE face R 55 E on SE face T 37 N on S W face R 54 E on NW face. At this cor I set off 15°44' on the arc and then run on meridian. Resulting latitude being 41°07'. Thence I run West on N Body of sec-1- over rolling land through heavy sage brush.
