Ascending E slope of Lone Mountain
Gradual ascent.

34.00 Draw course C.N.E

40.75 At 12 lbs S find $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. C or Well set.
Marked and returned as described
by Surveyor Gen. The pits being
nearly filled up and mound
partly destroyed. I dig pits
18x18x12 ins E and W of cor
3 ft dist and raised mound
of earth 3 ft base 1 1/2 ft high N of
C.W.

44.00 Top of low ridge bears N.E. and S.W.
ascending to drain

68.20 Draw course N.E. Ascending

81.14 At 24 lbs S. I find the cor of
Tps. 37 and 38 N Rs. 53 and 54 E
which is a stone firmly set in
the ground and marked as
described by the Surveyor Gen.
The mound of stone which is
partly destroyed is North of C.W. I
destroy mound and raise
mound of stone 4 ft base 2 1/2 ft high
S of C.W. 4 ft dist. S. 89° 50' W.
This stone corner of line is
Land Mountainous Soil Shiny 3rd rate.
