

8th Sta Parallel. R 546

Being unable to find any c.m. on the 8th sta. I go to the cor of T. 5, 41 N R 54 and 55 E on said sta which is only cor known by others and is shown me by James Holland.

Old S.C. is a slate badly decayed and markings nearly obliterated see trace of pits etc.

From this cor I run W on a Blank line and find the line irregular in bearing and distance, the old c.m. wholly or partly obliterated.

I therefore return to the cor of T 41 N R 54 and 55 E and Resurvey the 8th sta West through R 54 as follows.

At the S.C. Sp cor T 41 N R 54 and 55 E which I reestablish by setting a basalt stone 18 x 12 x 8 ins 12 ins in the ground at original point for c.m. Marked with 6 nails on the N E and W edge T 41 N on NW face R 55 E on NE face S.C. on N
Dig pits 30 x 24 x 12 ins E and
