At the Sta C of Secs.  
32 and 33 on 8th Sta N  
Range 55 E as described  
by the Surveyor Gen. At 7  
o'clock A.M. on June 28-1900  
I set off  $41^\circ$  on Lat Arc,  
 $23^\circ 19'$  on Dec. Arc. and  
determine a meridian  
of Solar observation. Thence  
I run North  $0^\circ 2' E$  bet sec  
32 and 33. Over Mts land  
rocky and broken.
