32 and 33. Over rolling land
through heavy sage brush.

23.00 Road turns N.E. and S.W.

40.00 Set a quartzite-stone $15 \times 10 \times 7$ ins

79.00 Road turns NW and S.E.

80.00 Set a quartzite-stone $16 \times 10 \times 6$
ins in a mound of stone 3 ft-
base and 2 ft high. for cor of
secs 32-33-28 and 29
