

N Bdy T 38 N R 53 E

At the cor of Tps. 39 N Ranges.
53 and 54 E which is a
stone set in a mound of 52 in.
At 7 o'clock A.M. on July 30th 1900
I set off 41° 12' on Lat Arc & 18° 34'
on Dec Arc. and determine
the true meridian by solar
observation. Thence I run
west on a true line to the
S Bdy of sec 36. Over Mt.
Lamb ascending.

23.00 Begin descent NW slope
28.50 Down course NE ascend
30.00 Top of ridge has NE and SW
40.00 Set a granite stone 14 x 9 x 5 in

cor marked 1/4 on N face
Dig pits 18 x 18 x 12 in E and W
3 ft. dist. and raise a mound
of earth, 3 1/2 ft. base 1 1/2 ft. high
N of cor.

6500 Top of ridge NE and SW
