- Preliminary to beginning the survey of subdivisions of this Sp. I receive E Body of sec 36. Run a bank line from the cor of Sp. 39 N R. 53 and 54 E full 2 lks E of 1/4 sec cor. stem mid of stem.

80.04 The cor of sec 25-36-30 and 31 which is a stem with mound of stone. I go to cor sec 35 and 36. At 8 o'clock AM on Aug 9-1900 at the cor sec 35 and 36. I set off $49^{\circ} 12'$ on Az. arc. $15^{\circ} 54'$ on Dec arc and determine the true meridian by solar observation. Thence I run $N 0^{\circ} 1' W$ bet sec 35 and 36 over Mt. land through heavy sage brush descending.
- 11.00 Run course E N E ascending
40.00 Set a basalt stone $14 \times 13 \times 6$ ins 10 ins in the ground from 1/4 sec cor marked 1/4 on W face dig pits $18 \times 18 \times 12$ ins N and S 3 ft. dia - and raise a mound of earth $3 \frac{1}{2}$ ft. tall
