

General Description

This township is composed of rough rugged rocky mountains partly covered with Aspen and Chaparral under brush. The Great Continental divide crosses through the following secs: 33, 34, 27, 26, 23, 14, 13, 12, 1 and 2. All the water N. W. of this divide flows into the Pacific while the remaining water flows into the Interior Basin.

This land is chiefly valuable as a sheep range during the summer.

In the middle W part of sec 6 is a power plant which furnishes Electric power for Tuscaraora. It is run by water which comes from a large spring in the center of sec 6.
