

General Description ³²⁷

This survey commences in Range 28 near the summit of the Trinity range and descends more or less gradually to the Granite Spring Basin, which is a depression with gradual slopes from E & west and a general trend N & S. The land here is good, could water be obtained & affords good grazing. In range 26 the Granite Range is crossed. Its general course is N & S. & consists of rough broken mountains descending in Sect. 25 into a similar basin running N.

The Nightingill range which occupies most of Range 25 is of a similar character very rough & broken.

The bottoms afford good grazing.
