Parallel N. through Tps 20 and 21 N. R. 21 E.

- Cho. July 10, 1903. At 8 h. a. m. I met
Kist off $39^{\circ}38'N.$ on the lat.
arc. and $22^{\circ}21'N.$ on the
decl. arc. and determine
a true meridian with
the solar at the cor. of
Tps. 20 and 21 N., R. 20 and 21 E.
Thence I retraced East
on a flank line and at
40.30 $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bears N. 11 lks. properly
marked as described in notes
of Surveyor General.

N. 23 lks. properly marked
and as described in notes
of Surveyor General.
- 120.96 $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bears N. 27 lks. properly
marked and as described in
