

Resurvey of S. Bdy of T. 19 N. R. 21 E.

Ch. After having retraced the South boundary of T. 19 N. R. 21 E. and finding old line out for distance and old corner nearly all destroyed or obliterated. I therefore deemed a resurvey necessary. therefore I resurvey as follows.

July 24, 1903. at 7h. 10. ^{min} a.m. l. rate
 I set off $39^{\circ}27'N.$ on lat. arc:
 $20^{\circ}4'N.$ on decl. arc. and
 determine a true meridian
 with the solar at the cor.
 of secs. 35 and 36 on the
 S. boundary.

Magnetic decl. is $17^{\circ}45'E.$

Thence I run W up on true
 line on S. bdy of sec. 35.

Over mountainous land
 through scattering sagebrush
 5.00 descend over steep rocky cliff
 90 ft. high.

8.00 Long Valley Creek course N. 10. l. so
 wide ascend

15.00 Ascend steep E. rocky slope
