Therefore I recovery as follows

July 27, 1903 at 8th. a.m. l.m.t.

I set off $39^{\circ}27'N.$ on last acre
 $19^{\circ}25'N.$ on the last. acre and
 determine a true meridian
 with the solar at the corner
 of secs. 35 and 36 witnessed
 and marked as described by
 the Surveyor General

Thence I run

North on a true line bet. secs.
 35 and 36

Over mountainous land
 through scattering sagebrush

Spur slopes S.W. descend

22.50

Recover corner W. ascend

36.00

Spur slopes W.

40.00

Find no trace of old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec.
