- Chas. July 29, 1903. at 8^h a.m. hmt
 I set off $39^{\circ}29'N$ on the lat.
 arc. and $18^{\circ}57'N$ on the decl.
 arc. and determine a true
 meridian, with the solar
 at the Cor. of secs 19, 24,
 25 and 30. on E. Bdy.
 Knowing I will fall out of
 limits, I run West on a
 true line bet. secs 24 and 25
 Over mountainous land and
 through scattering sagebrush
 17.00 Ridge bears NW. and SE descend
 30.50 Draw course NW. ascend
 40.00 Set Volcanic stone $36 \times 36 \times 30$ ins
 27 ins in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$
 sec. Cor. marked with $\frac{1}{4}$
 on N. face and raised
 mound of stone 2 ft. base,
 $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high N. of Cor.
 pits impracticable.
 47.00 Spur slopes NW. descend
 53.50 Draw course NW. ascend
 66.00 Spur slopes NW. descend
 73.50 Draw course NW. ascend
