

N. Bdy. T. 33 N. R. 38 E.

From the $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor. 1st. Secs. 4 and 33, on N. Bdy Tp. 33 N. R. 38 E., heretofore described I ran East on a random line along N. Bdy. T. 33 N. R. 38 E., setting temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ and sec. cor. at regular 40.00 and 80.00 chs. and at 273.00 Chs. Intersect E. Bdy. of Tp 33 N. R. 38 E. 3.40 Chs. S. of temp. cor. Tps. 33 and 34 N. Rs. 38 and 39 E. Set May 2nd 1904. I destroy temp. cor. and at point of intersection set a Tossel Stone 18 X 14 X 6 ins. 12 ins. in the ground for the cor. of Tps 33 and 34 N. Rs. 38 and 39 E. Marked with 6 notches on the N. S. E. and W. edges. T. 34 N. on N.E. R. 39 E. on S.E. T. 33 N. on S.W. R. 38 E. on N.W. faces. raise a mound of stone 2 ft. long $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high S. of cor. felt impracticable.
