May 3rd 1904 at the cor. of Tps.
32 and 33 N. Rs. 38 and 39 E.
I set off $15^{\circ}44'N$ on the declive
and at 1st I observe the sun
on the Meridian. Resulting
lat being $40^{\circ}41'N$, which is
within one minute of correct lat.

Thence I run
West on a flank line
bet. secs. 1 and 36
40.00 find no trace of old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
80.00 Old cor. sec. 1-2-35 and 36
which is a stake totally decayed
with markings almost obliterated
but with distinct traces of
mound and pits - face
South. 15 lbs. dist.

Thence West from old cor.
bet. sec. 2 and 35.
40.00 find no trace of old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
80.15 Intersect cor. of sec. 2, 3, 34
and 35. which is stake
totally decayed with markings
nearly obliterated and distinct
