I set off. $40^{\circ}36'N$. on lat. arc
 $21^{\circ}19'N$. on decl. arc. and
determine a meridian at
the cor. of Tps. 31^{and} 32 N. R. 39
and 40 E. heretofore described

Thence I run North on a
plank line at. sec. 31 and 36 at
40.00 ch. find no trace of $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
80.00 ch. find no trace of sec. cor.
I continue North.

Ret. sec 25 and 30

40.00^{ch} find no trace of $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. and at
80.20^{ch} the cor. of sec 19, 24, 25 and 30
which is a stake badly decayed
with traces of mound and pil-
lars W. 40. chs. dist.

North Ret. sec 19 and 24

40.00^{ch} find no trace of $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
79.91^{ch} the cor. of sec. 13, 18, 19 and 24.
bars W. 45 chs. dist.

I continue line North and at
480.23 ch. The cor. of Tps. 32 and 33
N. R. 39 and 40 E. which is a stake
badly decayed traces of mound and pil-
lars W. 102 chs. dist.
