

Subdivision of T. 33 N. R. 39 E.

June 14, 1904. At 8^h a.m. from Ft. I set off 23° 17' N. on decl. arc and 40° 41' N. on lat. arc and determine a true meridian with the solar at the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32 previously described by me.

Thence I run N. 0° 1' E. bet. secs. 31 and 32. Over mountainous land ascend over S.W. slope
4000 Set Basalt stone 14 X 10 X 6 ins. 10 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor. m.p.d. 1/4 on W. face and raise mound of stone 2 fr. base 1/2 fr. high W. of cor. pits impracticable

4400 Spur bears E. and W. thence descend over N. slope.

52.40 Ravine course W. ascend over S. slope

65.00 Ridge bears E. and W. descend over N. slope.

74.00 Ravine course W. ascend over S. slope.

78.00 Ridge bears E. and W.
