

## Resurvey of E. Bdy. T. 34N. R. 39E.

Remains scattered.

North Post, Secs. 1 and 6

40.15<sup>chs.</sup><sub>1</sub> old  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. granite stone 16 x 18 x 14  
ins. set in small mound of 8 ins

80.25<sup>chs.</sup><sub>1</sub> The cor. of Tps. 34 and 35 N, Rs.  
39 and 40. E, which is a basalt stone  
on top of ground with distinct traces  
of old mound and pits.

I destroy all traces of old cor.  
and reestablish in its original  
position by setting a basalt stone  
16 x 10 x 6 ins. 11 ins. in the ground  
for the cor. of Tps. 34 and 35 N  
Rs. 39 and 40 E. Marked with  
6 notches on the N. S. E and W, and  
T 35 N. on N. E, R 40 E. on S. E.

T 34 N. on S. W, R 39 E. on N. W, from  
dig pits 24 x 24 x 18 ins. N. E. and  
W. 4 ft. and S. 8 ft. dist and  
raise a mound of earth 5 $\frac{1}{2}$  ft.  
base 1 $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high S. of cor.

preservation and many of  
them missing entirely. I
