Could find no trace of old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec cor. The cor of Secs 25 and 36 bears west 28 chs dist.

I continue line North from said cor. and find no further trace of cor. though make thorough search at regular 40 and 80 ch points and at 5 miles 2 chs North of said cor. Secs 25 and 36

Dist N Bdy of Tps 6.00 chs East of old Cor of Tps 29 and 30 N Ranges. 46 and 47. E.

which is a fossil stone $18 \times 12 \times 10$ ins set in mound of stone and marked with 6 notches on the N. E, S and W edges. I
