At 7 o'clock A.M. on July 26
1901 I set off $40^{\circ}21'$ on lot arc
($19^{\circ}32'N$ on bee arc. and
determine the meridian by
solar observation.

Thence I run West on a
flank line set secs 1 and 36
Over Mts land.

4000 Can find no trace of old

West and at

80.12 Old cor of secs. 1-2-35 and
36 bears S 47° E 47 lks dist
The old cor is stone $19 \times 6 \times 4$ ins
set in small mound of stone
I destroy old cor and re-
establish by setting a fresh
stone $26 \times 17 \times 10$ ins in exact
position of old cor. in mound
of stone $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base 2 ft. high
for cor of secs 1-2-35 and
36 Marked with 1 notch on
the E and 5 notches on the
Wedge. pits unproductive
