

At the Cor of Ips. 30 N
Ranges 46 and 47 E. as
previously described
at 7 o'clock A.M. on
July 28, 1901, I set off
40° 26' N on Sat. arc 19° 6' N
on Dec arc and determine
the meridian by solar
observation. Thence I run
W on a flank line along
S Bdy see 36.

I continue West on a
flank line and at
7 miles and 79.96 Chs the cor of
secs 34 and 35 bears N 20° E
dist. Cor is a Rock line stone
24x12x10 ins set in small mound
of rock and marked with 4
notches on the W and 2
notches on the E edges.
I rebuild mound making
mound of stone $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base
2 ft. high. Then I
resurvey as follows
