



At the cor of Secs 1-2-35 and  
36. on S. Bay. Sp 30N R 45 E  
As previously described.

At 7 o'clock A.M. on Aug 12, 1901  
I set off  $40^{\circ}26'N$  on Sat arc.  
 $15^{\circ}07'N$  on Dec arc. and de-  
termine the true meridian  
by solar observation. Thence  
I run  $N0^{\circ}1'W$  bet sec 35

and 36. Over mts. land  
along <sup>W</sup> slope <sup>mean magnetic declination at</sup>  $71^{\circ}05'N$   $16^{\circ}45'E$

- 11.20 Dry drain course NW, ascend  
40.00 Set a granite stone  $15 \times 9 \times 4$  ins  
in a mound of stone 3 ft base  
1 1/2 ft high for 1/4 sec cor.  
marked 1/4 on W face  
pitts impracticable  
56.00 Top of ascent N.W. slope of  
Mtn. Descend N slope.  
70.00 Road bears N.E. and S.W.  
71.00 West fork Lewis Creek 5 cks wide  
course N.W. foot of steep descent  
begin ascent South slope  
72.00 House 50 cks west of line.  
77.50 Air compressor for morning  
stor. mine bears E about 5 cks.  
80.00 Set a basalt stone  $16 \times 12 \times 10$  ins
