

General Description

This is a very rough and rugged mountainous township with a number of very high rocky peaks in it.

It is well watered by springs in Sec 35 and 5, and also by Mill Creek and Trout Creek. The settlers located in secs 7, 18 and 32 using the water for irrigation purposes.

There are settlers claims in secs 19 and 7 the owners being absent.

The Dobbs raise good crops of Alfalfa on their place in Secs 7 and 18. Hoffman in sec 32 raise hay on their land.

The mountains are covered with sagebrush and a good growth of bunch grass making a good cattle range.
